Comment made by committee member that any wetland alteration on site should be compensated with wetland restoration in the same watershed. Scotian advised	

		that the compensation agreement was made with Ducks Unlimited. Scotian will request verification as to location of the wetland restoration project.	
6.0	Operation Update	<p>Scotian advised that blasting will resume mid April and notification will be sent out to committee members prior to blasting.</p> <p>Scotian advised that it and its parent company have been acquired by the Vinci Group. Scotian does not foresee any changes to its operating practices and company contacts and representation remain.</p>
